PAPER SUBMISSION

The main conference papers are limited to 8 pages long and must follow the IEEE proceedings format. They should be submitted as PDF via the conference's submission site: https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=cbdcom2018.

PAPER PUBLICATION

Accepted conference papers will be published by IEEE (IEEE-DL and EI indexed). At least one author of each accepted paper is required to register and present their work at the conference; otherwise the paper will not be included in the proceedings. Best Paper Awards will be presented to high quality papers. Selected papers will be recommended to journal special issues.
